- (a) Completed in its entirety (refer to addendum for applicable pension benefits legislation),
- (b) Signed by the spouse outside of the immediate presence of the member or former member and witnessed independently prior to the transfer, and
- (c) Filed with the pension plan administrator, RRSP underwriter or LIF/LRIF contract issuing company, as the cause may be; and
- (d) A copy should be given to the spouse who signed this Consent Form.
