This section explains why your information is collected and how it is used, shared and protected. It also explains how you can access your personal information.	The information you provide on this form is collected under the authority of the Canada Disability Savings Act (CDSA) and the Income Tax Act (ITA) for the purposes of determining eligibility for a Canada Disability Savings Grant (grant) or Canada Disability Savings Bond (bond), (including for previous years in order to determine if there are any unused grant and/or bond entitlements from those years), to calculate amounts payable and to administer the grant and bond. Information may be shared with Employment and Social Development Canada (ESDC), the Canada Revenue Agency, and the issuer for the administration of the CDSA and the ITA.			
	The Social Insurance Number (SIN) is collected under the authority of the CDSA and will be used as a file identifier and to ensure an individual's exact identification so that the beneficiary's eligibility for the Disability Tax Credit (DTC), residency and family income can be verified for the purposes of determining whether a grant or bond may be paid. While eligibility for the DTC may be verified, information contained within the Disability Tax Credit Certificate (i.e., the nature of the beneficiary's disability) will not be collected, used or disclosed.
