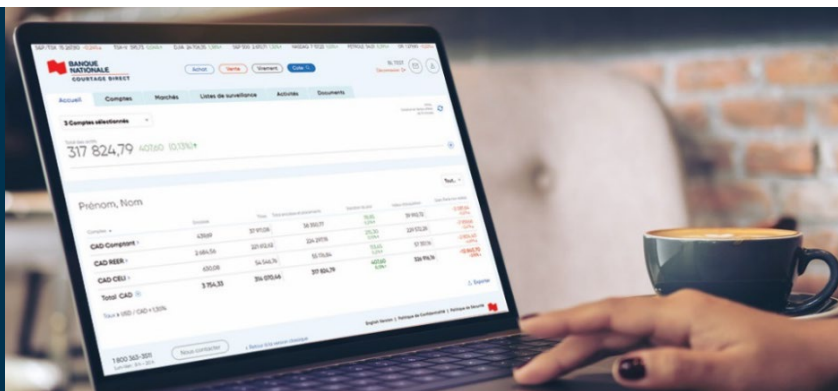


Create your easy access



Maybe you notice a yellow banner at the top of the National Bank Direct Brokerage online platform inviting you to switch to email identification. This ID will be unique for all your National Bank and subsidiary online services.

If you hold one of the account types below, the 8-digit user ID is still required for the moment.

- > Legal entities accounts (company accounts)
- > Joint accounts
- > Special accounts (guardianship, trust, etc.)

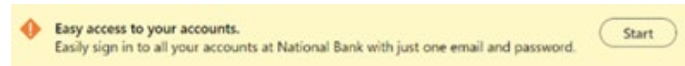
The 4 advantages of easy access:

- 1 **Simple:** Use a single email and password for all your National Bank online services.
- 2 **Secure:** Multi-factor authentication gives you enhanced security.
- 3 **Smooth:** Navigate all National Bank online platform with a single click.
- 4 **Mobile:** View your National Bank Direct Brokerage client account and trade on the new mobile app coming soon.

How to create your easy access:

When you see the yellow banner, click on *Start*.

Check the box: I confirm that I have read and understood the information on easy access. Click on *Continue*.

Sign in with your email

With this easy access, you will use your email to sign in to your National Bank and subsidiary accounts.

You will receive a verification code by email or text to identify yourself each time you sign in. To avoid receiving it each time, check the Remember me box on the sign-in page.

If we detect a change in your connection habits, you will receive a verification code.

Once your easy access is created

- Your 8-digit sign-in code will no longer be valid, nor will you be able to recover it.
- You will be able to navigate from one platform to another without having to identify yourself again.
- You will have to choose a new password, if necessary.
